The care group apprentice is the right hand man of the care group leader. The apprentice receives on the job training in care group leadership, engaging in roles such as leading couples and men's meetings, caring for members, and regularly providing feedback to the care group leader. The purpose is for the apprentice to take over the leadership of the care group or begin a new one.

## Responsibilities

---

- Be an example of a good care group member by being prepared for meetings and faithfully participating during the meetings.
- Lead one couples meeting every other month and the men's meeting every other month.
- Care for the members in that group that the care group leader designates by following up with them.
- After each meeting, take a few minutes to debrief with the care group leader – provide him with feedback about the meeting, but more importantly ask questions.
- Meet periodically with the care group leader to talk about the people in the care group to strategize how to care for the people more effectively.
- Regularly pray for your care group members.
- Participate any training seminars.
