Since its formation in March 2013, the Global Missions Committee (GMC) has been sharpening our understanding and practice of world missions. September marks the start of a new calendar year for the GMC and the opportunity to add a few energetic and visionary Committee members. If you think you might be interested, read on!

The GMC partners with the elders and the Missions Department to ensure that every member of Covenant Life Church has the motivation, training, and opportunity to engage in God's global mission. Under the delegated authority of the Board of Elders, the GMC:

- Manages and determines expenditures from the Global Missions budget (with quarterly reporting to the Board of Elders)
- Develops and maintains missions-related policies and procedures
- Researches best practices in missions methodology
- Evaluates all present and potential partners and projects to ensure compatibility with the church's vision and values
- Educates the church about missions and spurs church members to pray for global advance of the gospel
- Assists the Missions Department staff in selecting and facilitating short-term trips

The GMC meets monthly (typically on Tuesday nights). New members are asked to attend the Committee Retreat on Friday evening, September 16, and Saturday, September 17.
